3. Only one attempt is allowed for the test. Before taking it, please make sure your device works well, the network traffic is good and your surrounding is quiet enough.
4. Your attempt will have a time limit of 4 hours. When you start, the timer will begin to count down and cannot be paused. You must finish your attempt before it expires.
5. Switching screen is not allowed during the attempt. Please focus on the test and do not leave the test interface before completion.
6. The test consists of two parts with a total of 100 questions. Part 1 is about Grammar and Part 2 is reading and comprehension.
